Administrative Regulation

Key Elements

- New personnel must have completed basic training to receive award, but can apply when they become a member of the Kentucky National Guard
- Current education level on AGO Form 18-7 determines priority
- Financial assistance that is not required to go toward tuition will not affect the amount of award
- MGIB does not affect the amount of the award
- Must be a state supported university, community college, or vocational school
- Must be an active member in satisfactory standing
- Separate applications are required for each term during an award period
- Tuition award is for the school applied for(changes must be requested 30 days before school begins)
- Award period deadlines

January - April 1 October

May - July 1 April

August - December 1 April

- 6 STATUTORY AUTHORITY: KRS 164.746(6), 164.748(4),1996 Ky. Acts
- 7 ch. 220
- 8 NECESSITY, FUNCTION, AND CONFORMITY: The 1996 Regular Session
- 9 of the General Assembly established the Kentucky National
- 10 Guard Tuition Award Program and directed that the Department
- 11 of Military Affairs promulgate administrative regulations to
- 12 establish the eligibility of National Guard members to
- 13 participate in the program. This administrative regulation
- 14 establishes: (1) eligibility requirements; (2) the application
- 15 process; (3) individual and educational institution
- 16 notification; (4) educational institution verification; and (5)
- 17 referral for payment through the Kentucky Higher Education
- 18 Assistance Authority.
- 19 Section 1. Definitions.
- 20 (1) "Award Period" means the division of the year
- 21 established by the educational institution, such as a quarter,
- 22 semester, trimester, or summer session or other academic term.
- 23 (2) "Education Office" means the Kentucky National Guard

- 1 registered nurse, dental hygienist, physical therapy
- 2 assistant, engineering technology, or business technology.
- 3 (11) "Satisfactory Membership" means the member has:
- 4 (a) not failed the most recent physical fitness test;
- 5 (b) met the height-weight standard;
- 6 (c) met attendance standards for the past 12 months from
- 7 the date of application, to include :
- no unsatisfactory performance, and
- no absences-without-leave.
- 10 (d) no restrictions on his personnel file that prevent
- 11 positive personnel actions.
- 12 Section 2. Eligibility.
- 13 (1) A member shall not be eligible for a tuition award if
- 14 it has been determined that he has failed to meet the minimum
- 15 requirements for satisfactory membership in the Kentucky
- 16 National Guard.
- 17 (2) (a) Except as provided by paragraph (b) of this
- 18 Subsection, a member shall be eligible for a tuition award for
- 19 an award period that will end before the expiration of his
- 20 term of service.
- 21 (b) A member shall be eligible for a tuition award for
- 22 an award period that will end after the expiration of his term
- 23 of service if the member has submitted his signed application

- 1 the Kentucky National Guard.
- 2 Section 4. Priority of applicants. In the selection of
- 3 participants, priority shall be:
- 4 (1) given to a member who has not:
- 5 (a) earned an undergraduate degree; or
- 6 (b) received a certificate or diploma from a vocational
- 7 education program; and
- 8 (2) determined by date of receipt of application at the
- 9 Education Office.
- 10 Section 5. Application.
- 11 (1) An application for a tuition award shall be submitted
- 12 for each award period.
- 13 (2) Except for fall 1996, an application shall be filed on
- 14 or before:
- 15 (a) April 1, for an award period beginning:
- 16 1. May through July; and
- 17 2. August through December; and
- 18 (b) October 1, for an award period beginning January
- 19 through April.
- 20 (3) The member shall:
- 21 (a) complete a "Kentucky National Guard Tuition Award
- 22 Program Application" for the educational institution the
- 23 member plans to attend; and

- 1 (d) the amount of the tuition award granted each
- 2 applicant;
- 3 (e) control number for each applicant;
- 4 (f) date of award roster;
- 5 (g) signature and date signed by Education Services
- 6 Officer;
- 7 (h) educational institution certification statement,
- 8 signature, and date signed;
- 9 (i) educational institution fund transfer account entry
- 10 line, if applicable;
- 11 (j) adjusted amount of tuition entry line;
- (k) period of enrollment for each roster;
- (1) academic year;
- 14 (m) total number of eligible students; and
- 15 (n) total amount of awards.
- 16 (7) The Education Officer shall request the educational
- 17 institution to:
- 18 (a) verify enrollment; and
- 19 (b) state in the adjusted amount entry line the exact
- 20 amount of tuition charged the participant.
- 21 Section 6. The Kentucky Higher Education Assistance Authority
- 22 shall, to the extent that funds have been appropriated and are
- 23 available to the Kentucky National Guard Tuition Award

- 5. from a loan obtained by an applicant; and
- 2 6. from scholarships that are not restricted to
- 3 the payment of tuition.
- 4 Section 8. Appeals. A member whose application has been
- 5 disapproved, or whose application has been approved for an
- 6 amount disputed by the member, may request reconsideration, in
- 7 writing with supporting documents, through command channels to
- 8 the Adjutant General.
- 9 Section 9. Incorporation by reference.
- 10 (1) The following forms are incorporated by reference:
- 11 (a) "KENTUCKY NATIONAL GUARD TUITION AWARD PROGRAM,
- 12 APPLICATION AGO KyForm 18-7 (15 August 1996)"; and
- 13 (b) "KENTUCKY NATIONAL GUARD TUITION AWARD ROSTER AGO
- 14 KyForm 18-9 (1 August 1996)".
