- Students who complete ENG 105 must complete an additional 3 credit hours of General Education.
- Students who take the bypass exam for digital literacy must take another elective.
- Developmental courses (numbered below 100) cannot be used to satisfy graduation requirements.
- Must complete all required coursework with cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher to meet graduation requirements.
