- C or above in ENG 101
- Having all technical requirements up to date (state criminal background check, etc.)
- IECE declared as major
- Submission of personal autobiography

Progression in the IECE program is contingent upon achievement of a grade of "C" or better in each IEC course and maintenance of a 2.5 cumulative grade point average or better (on a 4.0 scale).
